The training is distinctively founded in Christian belief and focuses on God as Curegiver and we as Caregivers.

When the Stephen Ministers have completed their training, they will be commissioned and ready to begin their ministry. Working under supervision, a Stephen Minister will be available to meet weekly with a person experiencing such problems as these, and many more.
